Abstract of the talk:

While BEE should already be an important consideration in the design of sustainable turnaround strategies in SA, it will, in the near future, become a major catalyst contributing to the decline of otherwise healthy organisations. The presentation will explore the fundamentally strategic nature of BEE, why it is already key to the sustainability of turnarounds and how BEE itself is likely to introduce a new & unique flavour to the turnaround sector in SA.

About the speaker:
